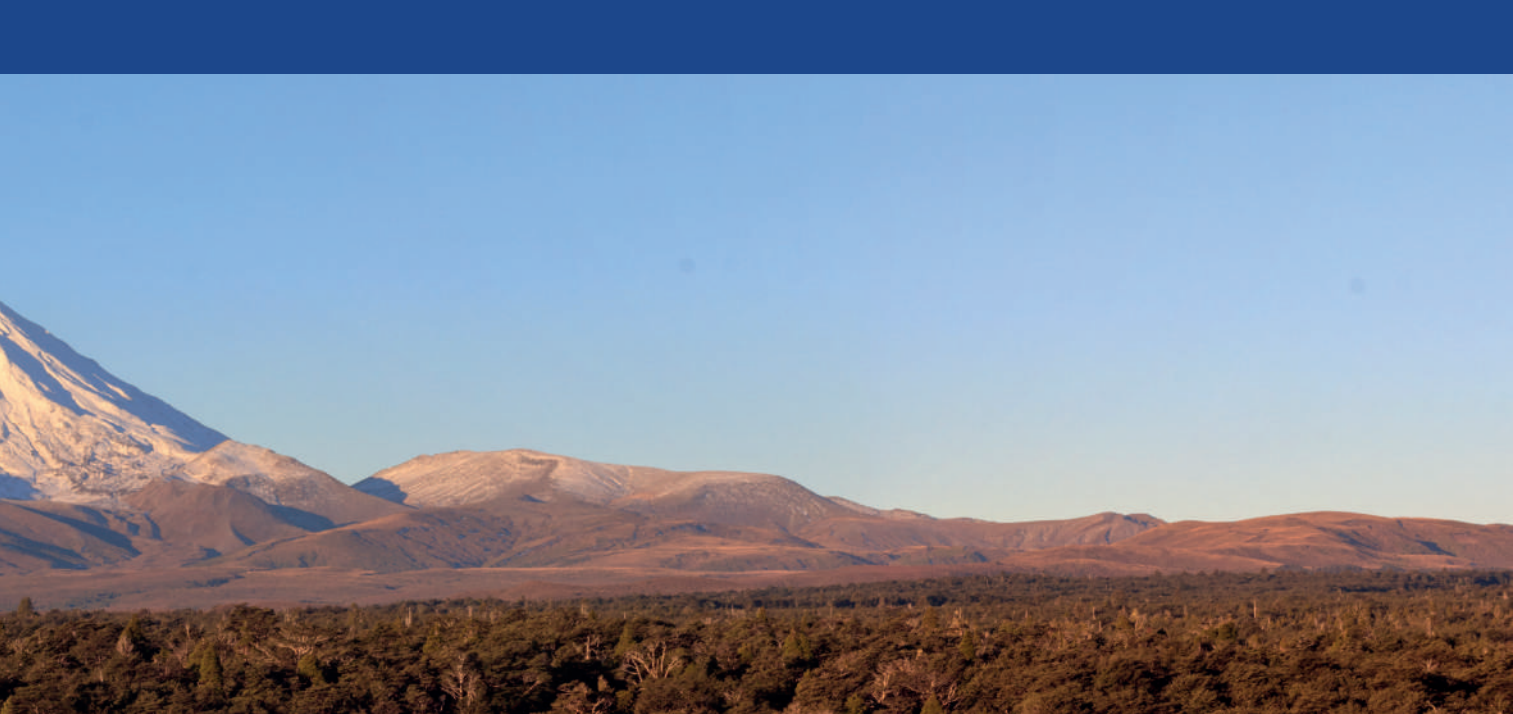
High-Quality Education: New Zealand's universities and vocational institutions offer a broad range of high-quality courses and degrees.

COMPLIANCE

CODE OF PRACTICE

When students choose to pursue their studies in New Zealand, it is crucial for education providers to fulfil their significant obligation of keeping these students well-informed, safe, and properly looked after.

The Code of Practice works as a comprehensive document that precisely delineates the legal obligations that education providers must adhere to when enrolling international students.

At Worldwide, we prioritize the safeguarding of our students by diligently complying with all the stipulations outlined in the code. The full, legislative version is also available on the New Zealand Legislation website.

PUBLIC TRUST

The New Zealand Government requires all private training establishments registered with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) to have some form of protection for fees paid to them in advance. This is a student fee trust account, which ensures that students receive a refund of the fees (or portion of fees) in case something happens to the provider due to closure, insolvency or loss of NZQA accreditation.

INSURANCE

It is mandatory for all international students to hold suitable medical and travel insurance while studying in New Zealand. At Worldwide, we offer an exceptional insurance package that provides the necessary coverage for students, ensuring their wellbeing in unforeseen circumstances.

ACADEMIC PROPOSAL

STUDY PROGRAMME

On the first day at school each student is interviewed by a senior teacher, who is in charge of designing a “Study Programme” based on the academic objectives of each student. Students move between levels when they have passed the required skills test for a level. These tests are given in week 3 and week 5 of the 6-week block.

STUDENT PASSPORT

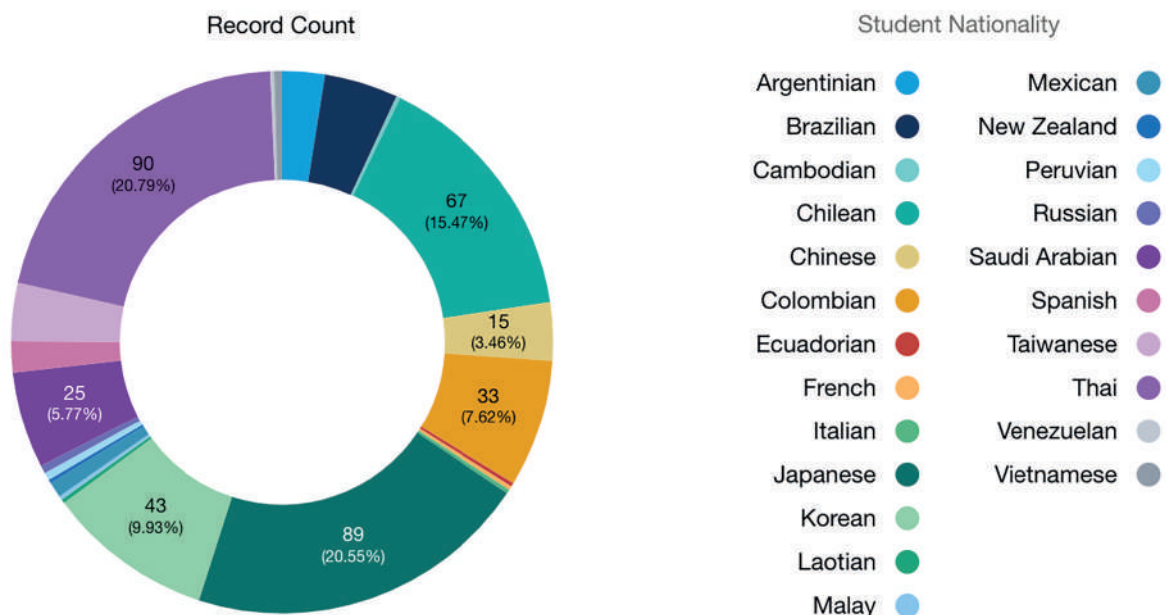
The entire learning process is reflected in a document called “Student Passport”

which is reviewed by the teacher and the student once every 6 weeks. If necessary, modifications are made for students to achieve their goals more quickly.

STUDENT CONFERENCES

Every 6 weeks, “Student Conferences” are held between the student and the tutor. In these meetings, the student’s progress and study goals are analysed, and modifications are made to the study plan if necessary.

GENERAL ENGLISH

This is a communicative course designed to improve your English language skills and give you more academic and professional options in the future. General English covers the skills of speaking, listening, reading, writing, grammar and vocabulary. As well as taking lessons, you will have plenty of time to sight-see and explore New Zealand.

ACADEMIC ENGLISH FOR EXAM PREPARATION

Academic IELTS

These courses provide comprehensive preparation for the world's most widely recognized English test, useful for employment, higher education or visa requirements.

- ▶ Full-time classes: Monday–Thursday, 9:00 am–2:20 pm and Friday 9:00am–12:00pm.
- ▶ Courses start every six weeks
- ▶ Pre-test required before enrolment
- ▶ Focus on skills practice, grammar, and topic-based vocabulary

Students also benefit from an IDP-endorsed visit to an official IELTS testing centre which includes: a test procedures presentation; Q&A session; and hands-on practice with the actual test-day computers.

We also offer a PM-only One Skill Retake (OSR) Writing course, running on a rolling three-week cycle.

CAMBRIDGE FCE / CAE/ CPE (SUBJECT TO DEMAND)

Cambridge English Qualifications are in-depth exams that make learning English enjoyable, effective and rewarding. Our unique approach encourages continuous progression with a clear path to improve language skills.

TOEIC (SUBJECT TO DEMAND)

Our TOEIC course is designed to enhance your English proficiency and test-taking skills. You'll engage in targeted practice tests and exercises covering all sections of the exam. This is a part-time afternoon course.

PTE (SUBJECT TO DEMAND)

Our PTE course can assist students in their university admissions, visa applications and professional registrations. This is a part-time afternoon course.

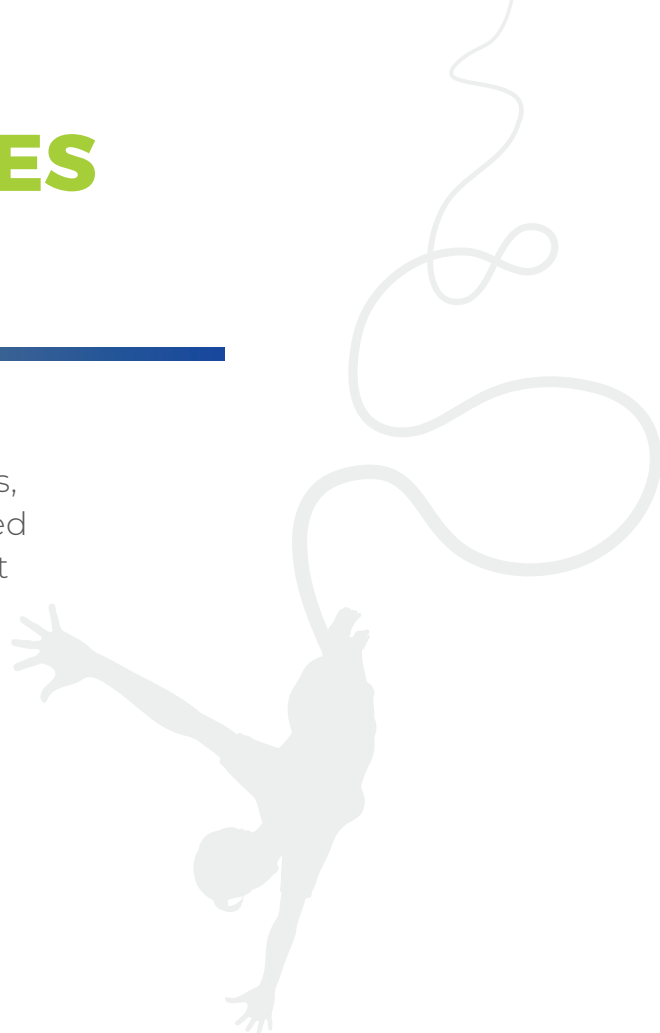


STUDENT ACTIVITIES CALENDAR

Whether students prefer the camaraderie of living with other students, or the warmth and support of a host family, student apartments, hostels and homestays all offer something unique and valuable to cater to the diverse needs and preferences of international students.

HOSTELS

Hostels are budget student accommodation. They are located in the heart of Auckland City, within an easy walking distance to Worldwide School.

Many hostels offer a range of free weekly activities to students.

HOMESTAY

Homestays offer a unique cultural experience, as students have the chance to live with a local host family.

This option allows for a deeper immersion into the local lifestyle and customs, fostering cross-cultural understanding and language development.

You will experience local food and 'kiwi culture'. We place students with local families to live with while studying at Worldwide School.

The homestay family will show them how to get to school on their first day.

All our families live close to a bus stop and the commute can be up to 45 and 60 minutes by bus.
